1) Fringe Fund

- a) Creating a fund from graduating companies that individuals can apply to if they are part of a production but can't afford to go
 - i) Need a timeline
 - (1) 2 members of committee paid for it
 - (2) Applications open from 7th week Hilary to 7th week Trinity
 - (3) Rolling basis but structured
 - (4) We want to encourage producers to book accommodation earlier
 - (a) OUDS requires receipts/invoices before we can pay anyone so this will give them sufficient incentive
 - ii) Need to think of how to take applications
 - (1) Getting actual form outlining income etc is problematic better to give people just a space to explain their need as they wish to
 - (a) But we could have tick boxes: bursaries, are you getting paid for the play? Have you applied to arts/travel funds in your colleges?
 - (2) Costs of accommodation £150-200
 - (a) Say that it's unlikely that you'll get more than £150
 - (3) Assessed by senior members we would need to vote on giving the senior members access to this fund
 - (4) Ask OUSU Class Act Officer to qualify whether we're doing this right
