- · Workshops:
 - Chris's workshop.
 - Chris to take care of Finalist workshops.
- RxJ Reviewing:
 - Inappropriate for OON to screenshot the email?
 - At the same time, very very unfair email.
 - Should be unspoken that you shouldn't fine student reviewers!
 - Don't want to make this a big issue.
 - It's about building an ethical atmosphere.
 - Don't have to make any formal gesture. We think it won't happen again.
- National Tour interview process:
 - The productions come to the **Exec**, they will interview them.
 - If Committee want to be in the interview room, they can be.
 - Unless you are involved in a bid for a show.
- Thelma Holt "International" Tour.
 - · Wanamaker Playhouse is very different.
 - Negligent in terms of access. Some people would have gone to the meeting if they had known it was London.
 - There was an implication that things were going to change, but largely very odd move.
 - OUDS could write a letter.
 - Important to discuss this in the proper way.

 - TAFF argue they are owed 50%
 - Lighting/Sound/etc.
 - · Student Technicians Meeting
 - Sorted out Tech forms for set and Props
 - · Had 16 people on Rota.
 - We also did the tech, DSM, SM, Positioning everything, setting up flats.
 - Logistical admin from Ell and Georgia was v big.
 - Put costs against it? Of course we will!
 - Very difficult for us to measure the amount of work we did.
 - TAFF did a lot during show week—but we did end up doing more—Georgia ended up answering a lot of tech questions etc.
 - We should go through with the next freshers rep.
 - TAFF have a much greater source of income than we do. Cuppers and NWF are our only regular income.
 - OUDS college reps organise cuppers.
 - Money goes straight back into drama.
 - In the past, OUDS kept 25%, TAFF had 75%.
 - We're all volunteers, we shouldn't expect remunerations via hours, but via what will best help drama.
 - ODA is a big pot of money that TAFF use. Whereas there's very little money in OUDS to fund shows.
 - Cuppers is a big access festival, that we put back into access.—Audition workshops, Grad Drinks, Diversity Drinks.
 - Vote: Give TAFF 25% of profit this year. 10 For, 3 abstentions,
 - Vote: Pay TAFF for last year 9: 8 For, 5 Abstentions
 - ACTION POINT: Charles to establish with TAFF that it will usually be a 75/25 split.

 - TAFF will build it, but they need us to help us archive.
- Termcard for Hilary:
